Abstract of AHF's Best Practice for HIV Linkage to Care:

AIDS Healthcare Foundation (AHF)'s Linkage to Care Team works closely with clients to provide one on one guidance and support to encourage clients' initiation and longevity of care. The Linkage to Care Team is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week (bilingual) and meets with clients face to face prior to initial appointment to assess clients' needs and eliminate any barriers to care. Transportation is provided to clients for their first two medical case management appointments. Additionally, the Linkage to Care Team hosts Meet and Greets between clients and medical case managers during the initial medical visit to ensure a smooth transition into the program.
