

Research Assistant to the National HIV Behavioral Surveillance System (NHBS) -MSM5 cycle

Position Description:

The position incumbent will be integral in accomplishing the research goals set by the Florida Department of Health as the funding agency for this project. This position is for a recruiter/interviewer/HIV test counselor for the NHBS-MSM5 2017 sampling phase, which is scheduled to be completed at the end of December 2017. This temporary position will end with the completion of the NHBS-MSM5 2017 sampling phase at the end of December 2017.

Principle Duties/Responsibilities:

- Aid in recruitment of potential study participants following study protocols within Miami-Dade County (40%).
- Screen and interview potential study participants; Conduct HIV counseling and testing; Conduct blood collection according to established study protocols (40%).
- Aid project director in conducting on-going community research and outreach throughout the project (10%).
- Participate in all training activities attendant to the implementation of the aforementioned duties, including attending training updates as required by project protocols and directives (10%).
- Other duties as assigned.

Minimum Requirements:

- High School Diploma or equivalent
- Willing/able to travel to NHBS locations in Miami-Dade County as required.
- Be willing to undergo required trainings and possess ability to establish and maintain positive relationships with the communities in which the target populations are located.
- Bilingual in English and Spanish preferred
- Florida Department of Health HIV Counseling Certification (HIV 500/501) preferred.
