PrEP is covered by most insurance companies and Medicaid. Some individuals may qualify for assistance paying for PrEP.

PrEP is a daily pill to reduce the risk of getting HIV.

Post-Exposure Prophylaxis (PEP) is taking medication after being potentially exposed to HIV to prevent becoming infected.
