People in the United States



**1.8 million students reached** by school health programs to reduce risk behaviors



**22% of the new HIV diagnoses** among 13-24 year olds



**3 million HIV test funded** by CDC annually 12,500 tested positive representing 1/3 of new diagnoses in the U.S.



Knowing one's status is the **first step** in getting care and treatment, and in **protecting others**. Ninety percent of new HIV infections are transmitted by people not diagnosed or not in care.

**\$14.9 billion** lifetime **medical costs averted** through HIV prevention between 2008 and 2014



**21,000** annual cases of **pelvic inflammatory disease prevented** through CDC funding of state and local STD programs



**4,000** annual cases of **infertility prevented** through CDC funding of state and local STD programs

**\$77 million** annual health care **costs saved** by preventing health problems caused by STDs



**800,000** hepatitis C **infections identified** if CDC's testing guidelines were followed



**320,000** hepatitis C related deaths would be averted through **linkage to care and treatment**

**\$6 billion** liver disease-related **costs saved** if testing and treatment guidelines for hepatitis C were followed



**319,000** cases of **TB prevented over the past 20 years** by CDC-supported state and local TB control programs

9,000 cases of disease each year



**\$14.5 billion** healthcare **costs averted** over the past 20 years through TB prevention
