1. Austin Eubanks:

Austin Eubanks is an injured survivor of the Columbine shooting and a powerful Keynote Speaker. His story of trauma, over-prescribed medications, and active addiction is sure to leave a lasting impression. Now in long-term recovery, Austin has devoted his career to helping those who have Journeyed into addiction by way of trauma. He speaks nationally regarding the addiction pandemic, drug policy, and the underlying issues of emotional pain and trauma. Austin will share his compelling story which started on that horrific day in April of 1999.

2. Sgt. Kevin Briggs:

As an international Crisis Management, Suicide Prevention, and Leadership Skills presenter, retired California Highway Patrol Sergeant Kevin Briggs' story and experiences have been featured in the Technology, Entertainment and Design 2014 Conference as a TEDTalk, Ciudad de Las Ideas (Mexico), Yahoo News, The New Yorker Magazine, Men's Health Magazine, NPR's Bob Edwards Radio Show, People Magazine, USA Today, as well as other magazines, newspapers, radio, and podcasts across the world. His first book, Guardian of the Golden Gate: Protecting the Line Between Hope and Despair, was released in July 2015.

3. Kevin Berthia

Kevin is living each day in gratitude after Sgt. Kevin Briggs talked him back over the ledge of The Golden Gate Bridge in 2005. Kevin Berthia has since become a Suicide Prevention Advocate, encouraging people to talk through their problems rather than think about ending their lives. Kevin believes that depression may be a part of you, but it is not who you are. In May of 2013, Kevin was invited by The American Foundation for Suicide Prevention (AFSP) to present The Life Savers Award to the officer who talked him back to safety. he spoke publicly for the first time about the events that led up to that day on March 11, 2005. His story of HOPE has been featured by multiple media outlets including Nightly News with Brian Williams, ABC Fusion, The Steve Harvey Show, Men's Health Magazine and People Magazine.

4. Darlene Slaughter

Darlene Slaughter is the Vice President and Chief Diversity Officer at United Way Worldwide. She is currently leading efforts to expedite and advance worldwide diversity and inclusion strategies, partnerships and initiatives by working closely with local United Ways, as well as corporate and community partners. Darlene has won many awards and honors, including SAVOY's "2012 Top 100 Influential Women in Corporate America," profiles in Diversity Journal's list of "Women Worth Watching," Black Enterprises' "Top Executives in Diversity" and Heart & Soul's "Women of Substance in Finance." Darlene is also a frequent speaker on topics such as changing management, women's initiatives, financial literacy, leadership development, and concepts on diversity and inclusion.
