MBCHC is a fully integrated ambulatory care medical facility that provides the entire spectrum of primary health care services and select specialty care services. The National Committee for Quality Assurance (NCQA) has certified MBCHC at the highest level as a Patient-Centered Medical Home. In 2017 MBCHC provided 192,042 health care visits to its patients.
