

Summary of Findings


- The Ryan White Program (RWP) spent a total of \$21.9 million in FY 2018/19, a 6.4% decrease over the \$23.4 million spent in FY 2017/18.
 - The largest proportion was spent on Outpatient/ Ambulatory Health Services (OAHS, \$9.1 million) followed by Medical Case Management/Peer Education Support Network (MCM/PESN, \$5.3 million) and Oral Health Care (OHC, \$2.8 million).
 - Among support services, the largest proportion was spent on Substance Abuse Services (Residential) (\$1.8 million) and Food Bank (\$1.4 million).
- A total of 9,578 clients were served by the Program in FY 2018/19, a 3.1% decrease over FY 2017/18.
 - Almost all RWP clients received MCM/PESN services (8,496) while just over half (5,447) received OAHS thru the RWP and one-third (3,381) received OHC.






Medical Case Management (MCM) (including Treatment Adherence) & Peer Education Support Network (PESN)



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
- The majority of RWP clients (80%) received MCM services in FY 2018/19. The number served was a 3.5% increase over the number served in FY 2017/18.
- Just under one-quarter of all RWP expenditures (\$4.6 million) was spent on MCM in FY 2018/19 – the highest proportion in more than five years.
- Just under 75% of all RWP clients received PESN services in FY 2018/19 with just under \$700,000 spent on the category.
- In terms of specific MCM/PESN services, MCMs were most likely to spend time and resources on client face-to-face encounters and case documentation.



Outpatient/Ambulatory Health Services (OAHS)



In FY 2018/19, the largest proportion of RWP dollars (41.5%) were spent on OAHS – \$9.1 million – the largest proportion in more than five years and 33% more than in FY2017/18.

 More than half of all RWP clients (5,447) received OAHS thru the RWP, an 8% increase over FY2017/18.

- Top OAHS by expenditure included a 25-minute patient office visit, a 15-minute patient office visit, and HIV testing.
- Top OAHS by clients served included HIV-testing, blood tests, and T-cell tests.



Health Insurance Premium & Cost Sharing Assistance (HIP/CSA)



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 Due to ADAP assuming responsibility for ACA marketplace insurance premium payments for over 500 Part A clients in FY 2018/2019, the dollars spent on this service category by the RWP dropped drastically from \$5.4 million in FY 2017/18 to just over \$500,000 in FY 2018/19.

- The number of RWP clients served remained relatively stable at 1,307. This was because the RWP continued to cover copayments/deductibles for medication, office visits and lab/diagnostic tests.
- The service was more likely to be used by Hispanic males than either Black males or Black females.



Oral Health Care (OHC)



 Utilization of OHC has remained relatively stable over the last five years with one-third (35%) of all RWP clients using the service.

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
- Just over 10% of all RWP expenditures -- \$2.8 million was spent on OHC with an average of \$849 spent per client served.
- Top dental services by expenditure included fillings and cleanings while top services by number of clients served oral examinations, panoramic x-rays, cleanings, and oral hygiene instructions.

AIDS Pharmaceutical Assistance (Local) (APA)



 The expansion of the ADAP formulary to include non ARVs in FY 2017/18, had a notable impact on the utilization of the RWP's APA in FY 2018/19.


- The number of RWP clients receiving pharmaceuticals from the RWP dropped 40%, from 1,162 in FY 2017/18 to 697 in FY 2018/19.
- The dollars spent dropped 80.5% from \$441,202 to \$86,210.
- The most frequently dispensed pharmaceuticals both in terms of dollars spent and clients served were Doxycycline (an antibiotic) and the testosterone injection Enanthate/ Cypionate.
- Both Hispanic males and White males were more likely to receive pharmaceuticals thru the RWP than other gender/ethnic groups.

 At the same time, the dollars spent increase 20% from \$112,346 to \$133,790.


- Most of the cost in this service category were due to clients receiving level II individual mental health counseling.

 The number of clients receiving Outpatient Substance Abuse Services (SAS) remained relatively stable between FYs 2017/18 (120) and 2018/19 (115).

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• At the same time, the dollars spent decreased by half from \$110,357 to \$55,390.

- Two-thirds (63%) of this service category's expenditures were due to Level I individual SAS counseling followed by Level II group counseling.
- Both Black males and Black females, along with White females, were more likely to utilize this service compared to the other gender/ethnic groups.






- At the same time, the total number of clients served remained about the same 709 in FY 2017/18 vs. 701 in FY 2018/19.

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


