

Subject: FW: SPCC Security Screening Prohibited Restricted Items

Good Afternoon,

Beginning the week of Tuesday, September 3, Employee and Visitor screening at Stephen P. Clark Center will go into effect. Upon entering the new security screening area, all Employees will be required to present their County ID in order to utilize the employee dedicated screening equipment. All personal belongings will be screened, and everyone will walk through the magnetometers. Additional screening may require the use of hand wands or a secondary screening device. Prohibited items will not be allowed into the facility and will be confiscated. In order to exit the facility, all Employees and Visitors must go through the turnstiles.

This implementation requires the following changes be made to existing entrance and exit points. Employees and Visitors will be required to enter through the East and West lobby doors only. The South doors will only be utilized in case of an emergency.

During the week of September 9th, a separate Visitor Management system will require anyone without a County ID to check-in and receive an identification badge prior to entering the screening area. Miami-Dade Police Officers will continue to be present in the screening area to support the security screeners and provide immediate response as needed. ISD Building Management will closely monitor the area and will adjust as needed to enable an efficient flow of employees and visitors in and out of the screening area.

SPCC Security Screening

Prohibited & Restricted Items

Prohibited Items:

- **Firearms** including but not limited to: **flare guns, starter guns, spear guns, BB/pellet guns, air-soft guns, paintball guns, replica guns and toy guns**
- **Stun Guns** including but not limited to: **tasers, cattle prods, shocking devices** of any kind
- **Ammunition** of any kind
- **Firearm-shaped Lighters**
- **Bladed Weapons** including but not limited to: **knives 4 inches or over, axes, hatches, swords or throwing stars**
- **Explosive materials** including but not limited to: **gun powder, black powder, smokeless powder, nitroglycerine, dynamite, fireworks, plastic explosives, blasting caps, primers and percussion caps**
- **Explosive devices** including but not limited to: **bombs, grenades, inert grenades, land mines, inert land mines and rockets**
- **Incendiary devices** (except cigarette lighters as listed in the **Restricted Items** list below) including **flamethrower, Molotov cocktail, and items with wicks**
- **Flammable liquids** including but not limited to: **gasoline, alcohol, ether, lighter fluid, paint thinner and turpentine**
- **Caustic Alkalis and Acids** including but not limited to: **acetic acid, ammonia water, arsenic, carbolic acid, hydrochloric acid, hypochlorous acid, nitric acid, oxalic acid, potassium hydroxide, silver nitrate, sodium hydroxide and sulfuric acid**
- **Striking objects** including but not limited to: **slingshots, night sticks, billy clubs, black jacks, expandable batons, nunchakus or kubatons**
- **Sporting goods equipment** including but not limited to: **baseball bats, bow and arrows, golf clubs, hockey sticks and pool cues**

Items Restricted to Public:

- **Any cutting blade and/or piercing instrument** including but not limited to: **knives under 4 inches, scissors, box cutters, corkscrews, hair picks with metal tines, knitting needles, metal nail files, letter openers, ice picks or utility knives**
- **Mace or pepper spray**
- **Tools** including but not limited to: **crowbars, drills, hammers, pliers, saws, screwdrivers and wrenches.**
- **Chemicals** including but not limited to: **gas, butane or butane operated items, chlorine, compressed gas cylinders, liquid bleach, alcohol, and spray paints.**
- **Restraining devices** including but not limited to: **thumb cuffs, handcuffs, handcuff keys, leg shackles, flex cuffs, tie wraps, wire, chains or rope**
- **All liquids or gels in excess of 3.4 ounces**
- **All lighters**
- **Aerosol cans**
