### HRSA RELEASES INAUGURAL RYAN WHITE HIV/AIDS PROGRAM ORAL HEALTH DATA REPORT

The inaugural RWHAP Oral Health Data Report, 2017 provides a deeper look at service utilization, demographic, and socioeconomic factors among clients served across RWHAP oral health programs and the characteristics of RWHAP-funded organizations that deliver oral health services.

## HRSA ANNOUNCES HIGHEST HIV VIRAL SUPPRESSION RATE IN NEW RYAN WHITE PROGRAM CLIENT-LEVEL DATA REPORT

(HIV.gov) A new report released last week by HRSA shows that clients receiving Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program medical care were virally suppressed at a record level  $-87.1\,\mathrm{percent}$  – in 2018. This means people with HIV who take medication daily as prescribed and reach and maintain an undetectable viral load have effectively no risk of sexually transmitting the virus to an HIV-negative partner.

HHS Seeks Vendor(s) to Distribute PrEP Medications as Part of Ready, Set, PrEP

HHS requires a vendor(s) to distribute PrEP medications as part of a donation agreement between HHS and Gilead to provide PrEP medication at no cost for up to 200,000 individuals a year who are at risk for HIV and who are uninsured.

#### Ready, Set, PrEP Expands Access to Medication to Prevent HIV

Ready, Set, PrEP, a national program that makes medications for PrEP, taken daily to prevent HIV, available at no cost to people without prescription drug insurance coverage.
