NEW PUBLIC CHARGE RULE IS IN EFFECT AS OF FEB. 24, 2020 -**IMMIGRATION & THE RYAN WHITE PROGRAM**

(Reposted from 11/15/19) Message From the Miami-Dade County Office of Management and Budget Grants Coordination/Ryan White **Program:**

It has come to our attention that people with HIV who are in the process of seeking admission to the U.S. or an adjustment in their immigration status fear that enrollment or participation in the Ryan White Program may jeopardize their chances for a successful immigration outcome. Even some attorneys are telling them this, in error. Please let clients in this situation and/or their attorneys know that, per the U.S. Department of Homeland Security's final rule on public charge (dated August 14, 2019), the Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program is exempt from the "public charge" restrictions. [Click here for the Final Rule report and note the highlighted sections.] It is critical to remind clients of the importance of HIV treatment adherence to their overall health and the health of our Miami-Dade community.
