
March 10: Women and Girls HIV/AIDS Awareness Day

HHS Seeks Vendor(s) to Distribute PrEP Medications as Part of Ready, Set, PrEP

HHS requires a vendor(s) to distribute PrEP medications as part of a donation agreement between HHS and Gilead to provide PrEP medication at no cost for up to 200,000 individuals a year who are at risk for HIV and who are uninsured.

Ready, Set, PrEP Expands Access to Medication to Prevent HIV

Ready, Set, PrEP, a national program that makes medications for PrEP, taken daily to prevent HIV, available at no cost to people without prescription drug insurance coverage.
