

COUNSELING AND NAVIGATION LEAD

Latinos Salud is seeking qualified individuals for this full-time position. Working primarily from the Miami Beach location, the Lead will:

- Monitor and improve the quality of the risk reduction counseling program.
- Oversee, monitor, and report timely input of counseling session data;
- Personally recruit, enroll, and provide risk reduction counseling to HIV+ men;
- Provide CLEAR counseling sessions to eligible clients.
- Perform online and in-person outreach to gay Latinos and to other gay/bisexual men in who are living with HIV;
- Supervise the Broward Counseling and Navigation Lead, and all Wellness Navigators;
- Track outcomes of navigations to primary care and to other essential support services.
- Facilitate support group meetings.
- Serve as an overflow HIV/STD test counselor and assist with outreach:
- Participate in other agency programs and committees that serve the community.

Latinos Salud is Florida's only gay, minority-based HIV agency. With locations in Miami-Dade and Broward County, Latinos Salud seeks to reduce the burden of communicable diseases, using a community engagement model.

The successful candidate will (i) have a bachelor's degree in social work, psychology, nursing, public health, or similar; (ii) be fully bi-lingual (Spanish and English); (iii) have experience in counseling, especially with minority and LGBT populations; (iv) have experience working with, or volunteering in programs that serve gay men, especially gay Latinos, and (v). Have experience overseeing staff and units of service Candidates must also complete the Florida 500 / 501 HIV testing certification. Must have own transportation, and be willing to work a flexible schedule.
