



(TargetHIV) Women accounted for 19% of new HIV diagnoses in the United States (CDC, 2020). In 2019, 26.2% of Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program (RWHAP) clients were female, with minority women comprising 84% of RWHAP female clients, specifically: 61.3% African American, 19.4% Latina, and 16.4% white (HRSA, 2020) . . .
