

# Case Study Submissions on PrEP Access Issues Requested for the FDOH Miami PrEP Workgroup

Seeking case study submissions on PrEP access issues for the next meeting on Wednesday, May 26, 2021.

Example: A private medical practice that doesn't often write prescriptions for PrEP did so for a patient with Medicare on a United HMO where his Truvada co-pay would have been \$700.00 and his generic co-pay would have been \$500. The doctor's office didn't know what to do and sent him to one of our members. The patient's annual income was well over the 400% FPL. What would could have been done for this client?


