



JOB OPENING HIV+ PEER NAVIGATOR

Care 4 U Community Health Center has an opening for a full or part-time HIV+ Peer Navigator for its Ryan White Program. Peer Navigators are HIV+ individuals who work to encourage engagement into care and support adherence to treatment by providing client centered services. Peer Navigators are integral to Care 4 U's Ryan White medical case management and treatment adherence programs and provide specialized services in a professional environment. Peer Navigators will:

- Work collaboratively with primary care and case management staff to identify newly diagnosed clients who can benefit from peer support, by offering hope and living proof that living with HIV is possible
- Support clients in navigating the Ryan White service delivery system by educating new clients on the process of accessing core and support services
- Provide "peer support," including client orientation and education about health and social service delivery systems.
- Assist with initial client intake, paperwork, and applications for financial and medical eligibility,
- Accompany clients to initial appointments for medical care and other services.
- Make phone calls to clients for the purpose of reminding them of medical appointments, in order to improve the client's attendance at appointments and reduce no-shows.

Educational/Experience Requirement

- Must be HIV+ and have at least three (3) years' experience receiving Ryan White services
- Must have a high school diploma/GED.
- Knowledge of HIV/AIDS required
- Basic computer (typing, email, Word) skills necessary
- Good interpersonal skills and the ability to relate to diverse groups of people is also required
- Must be willing to share your story of living with HIV with clients

Preferred Skills

- Bilingual (English/Spanish) preferred, Trilingual (English/Spanish/Creole) highly desired
- Experience serving people living with HIV/AIDS preferred & knowledge of Miami-Dade County HIV/AIDS service delivery system is preferred.

Benefits include paid holidays and time off, 401K and for full-time staff, paid health, dental, vision and life insurance.
