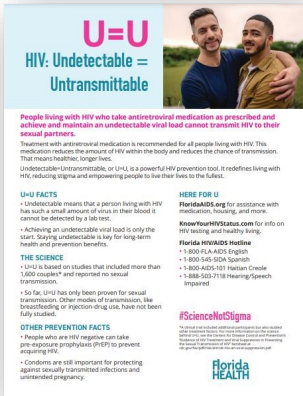

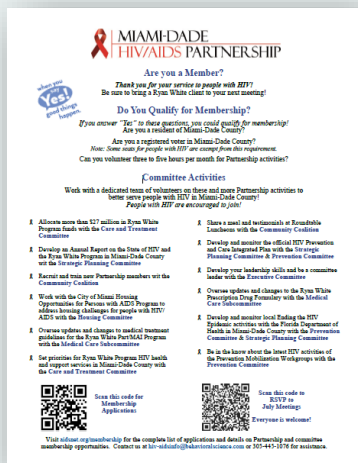


JOIN THE PARTNERSHIP

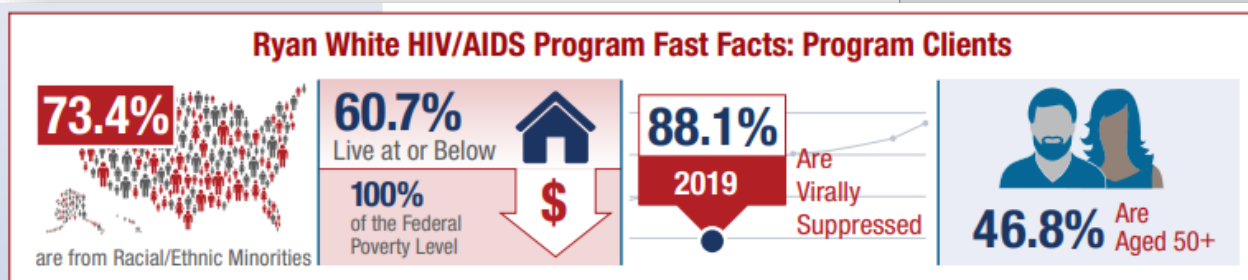

A message from Legal Services of Greater Miami



2021 Advance Child Tax Credit Payments
Payments start July 15

Find a strategy! You don't need to file any return now if you've had a 2020 tax return.

Eligible taxpayers include anyone whose payments of up to \$500 per month for each child (up to \$3,000 per year) begin July 15 and will be made monthly through December to anyone who is not required to file a tax return and who did not file in 2020. (You'll receive the IRS Next Day Right-up Trust. You can qualify for the Child Tax Credit and Economic Impact Payments.

Eligible taxpayers who don't want to receive payments of the 2021 Child Tax Credit will have the opportunity to opt out of receiving the payments.



July 1, 2021
We're Getting Back to Normal!
Governor DeSantis has removed all Emergency Orders effective July 1, 2021.

What this means for you!

- Beginning July 1, 2021, all Partnership, committee and subcommittee meetings will be held in person only.
- Regular member attendance requirements apply, including:
 - Five (5) absences from scheduled Partnership or committee meetings in any County fiscal year shall constitute grounds for removal.
 - A member who attends the meeting for less than 75% of the scheduled or actual duration of the meeting, whichever is less, is counted as absent from a meeting.

COVID-19 Safety

- Attendees are encouraged to wear a mask.
- Meeting rooms will be arranged to allow for social distancing.
