- ◆ Partnership, committee and subcommittee meetings will return to the hybrid format (in-person and Zoom), beginning with the Partnership meeting on August 17, 2021.
- ◆ **Members**
 - ◆ **In-person quorum of members is required.**
 - ◆ Members are expected to attend the meeting in person.
 - ◆ Regular meeting attendance requirements apply as outlined in the Bylaws.
 - ◆ Members may attend via Zoom if your non-attendance at the meeting is due to medical necessity.
 - ◆ Members who need to attend via Zoom must submit the *Request to Participate by Communication Media Technology* no later than 48 hours prior to *each* meeting.
- ◆ **Guests**
 - ◆ Guests are encouraged to attend via Zoom.
 - ◆ Guests must RSVP for the Zoom link.

- ◆ Attendees at meetings held at the Miami-Dade County Main Library are now required to wear a mask. *Masks are available at all meetings.*
- ◆ Meeting rooms will be arranged to allow for social distancing.
