I. Business Items

▪ **Call to Order**

Committee Chair, Sannita Vaughn, called the roundtable to order at 12:17 p.m.

▪ **Resource Persons**

Behavioral Science Research Corp. (BSR) staff were identified as resource persons.

▪ **Review Agenda**

The committee reviewed the agenda. Membership update was added and the presentation by John McFeely was moved to the first item in the Roundtable.

Motion to approve the agenda with changes noted above.

▪ **Floor Open to the Public**

Ms. Vaughn opened the floor to the public with the following statement:

“Pursuant to Florida Sunshine Law, I want to provide the public with a reasonable opportunity to be heard on any item on our agenda today. If there is anyone who wishes to be heard, I invite you to speak now.”

Each person will be given three minutes to speak. Please begin by stating your name and address for the record before you talk about your concerns.”

There were no comments. The floor was then closed.

- **Review the Minutes of July 26, 2021**

Members reviewed the July 26, 2021 meeting minutes (copy on file). There were no changes.

Motion to approve the July 26, 2021 meeting minutes as presented.

- **Membership**

Staff advised members that Liam Mugavin had resigned due to relocating outside of Miami-Dade County.

Staff received an application for committee membership Alberto Bermudez-Perez. Mr. Bermudez-Perez introduced himself and stated his interest in joining the committee. Members asked him to confirm he will attend regular monthly meetings and work for the good of the HIV community as a whole. Mr. Bermudez confirmed his commitment and members voted to accept his application.

Motion to accept Alberto Perez-Bermudez as a member of the Community Coalition Committee.

Mr. Perez-Bermudez was welcomed as a new member.

Guests Harold McIntyre and Lamar McMullen requested applications which can be voted at the next meeting.

II. Roundtable

- **A Work of ART**

Member John McFeely presented a summary of the viral suppression communication campaign, A Work of ART. The campaign celebrates people with HIV as “works of ART” and seeks to reduce stigma and discrimination, build community trust, and create linkages between people with HIV and community stakeholders. The campaign is being launched in English and Spanish, with a Spanglish version pending.

Mr. McFeely and BSR staff were designated as the Work of ART liaisons representing the Miami-Dade HIV/AIDS Partnership.

Mr. McFeely also announced the Anchor Study, a 5,000 nation-wide person study to improve anal cancer diagnosis and treatment. Cards in English and Spanish promoting the study were distributed (copies on file). Several attendees noted problems accessing the study due to insurance billing requirements. Mr. McFeely stated he would address the issue with the Anchor Study Steering Committee.

- **Testimonials**

Mr. Perez-Bermudez spoke briefly about his advocacy around the needs of heterosexual Hispanic men and requested assistance with promoting his story through a book, social media, and a website.

▪ **Roundtable Discussion: Are you experiencing barriers to care?**

Attendees held an open discussion as summarized below:

- Distrust of insurance companies; having care managed through insurance company depersonalizes the doctor/service provider-patient relationship.
 - There is no longer “that one place” where you go for care; stable relationships are not built which leads to distrust and confusion.
- Lack of training and/or applying tools of cultural competency leads to distrust of service providers. Need to acknowledge racial discrimination exists in the service system.
- Finding specialty care is difficult with insurance and within the RWP care system.
- Getting appointments in a timely manner is difficult.
- ACA plans are not equipped to serve people with HIV:
 - Clients need to be careful because providers are not knowledgeable about HIV-care-specific treatment
 - Clients are being referred to specialty care for labs and medications.
 - Where case management is received and by whom makes a difference in care and navigating the care system.
- More peer educators/consultants/Subject Matter Experts need to be working in the service system.
- Funds should be designated to pay peers who are currently working as volunteers. Stop exploiting passion and compassion since peers are the best suited to understand other persons who are HIV positive. This may also apply to persons with substance use disorders.
- More job opportunities should be geared toward people with HIV.
- Looking for access to lung cancer screening.
- Access to insurance is not the same as access to care.
- Need to think of “clients” as “participants” in their healthcare and as “family”
- Housing
 - No housing = no medical care
 - Clients may “cross the border” between Miami-Dade and Broward Counties depending on available services and housing which creates a disjointed care plan and being lost to care.
 - Unstable housing impacts Black/African American clients disproportionately.
 - Some landlords will not accept HOPWA funding.
- Mental health and addiction.
- Basic financial literacy training.
- Get someone to teach you and then you become the teacher.
- Follow Up with Committees
 - Peer Educator Service Category Review – How are peers utilized in their agencies? (Care and Treatment Committee)
 - Housing, particularly for Black/African American clients (Housing Committee)
 - Can peers be included in Medical Case Management training? What kind of training is required for peers? (Clinical Quality Management)
- How do incarcerated populations receive care?
 - What is status of Jail Linkage Coordinator? This service is needed.
 - It is very easy to give up hope after release from jail/prison.
- Clients need to be their own advocates – don’t take “no” for an answer!
- Clients feel they are going through intake just to be counted; feel like a number not a person.
