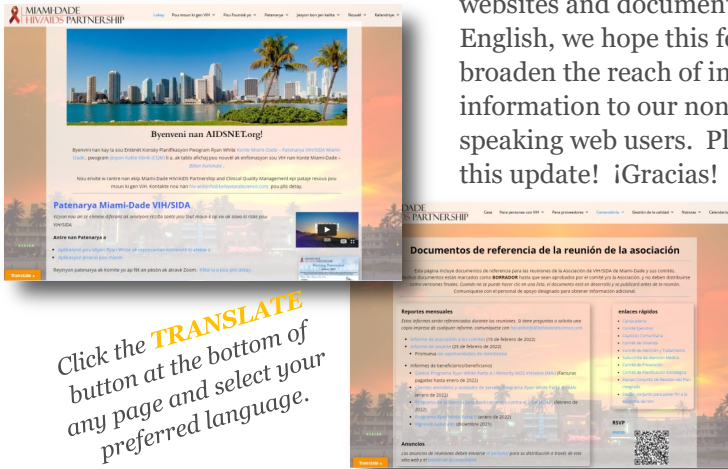

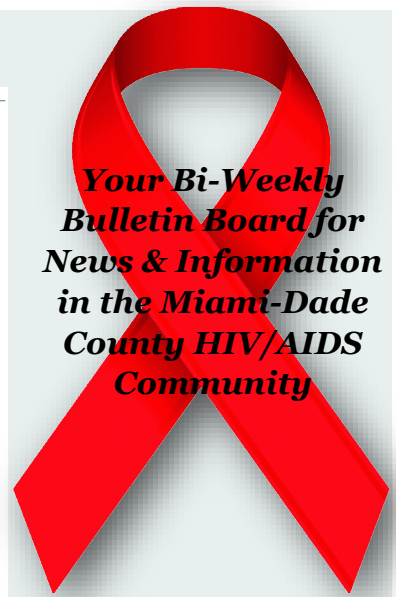

The Positively Quit Study

Now expanded to 13 states! The program is free and very helpful and effective for people looking to quit smoking cigarettes. Program participants earn up to \$370 for completing activities in the program.

University of Florida Survey for Men between 18-30 years old

Health and alcohol use; \$35 for eligible participants.

PrEPTECH

A paid study to see if an online program will help people who aren't already on PrEP start and continue taking it. Looking for young gay or bi men and trans women in California or Florida who aren't already on PrEP to join our PrEPTECH study.

Minority AIDS Initiative Grant

To increase engagement in care for underrepresented individuals with substance use disorders (SUD) and/or mental disorders (COD) who are at risk for or are living with HIV/AIDS and receive HIV/AIDS services/treatment. Agency: SAMSHA; Due: April 25, 2022.

Positive Action Community Grants (PACG)

Through Positive Action Community Grants (PACG), ViiV Healthcare supports community-led efforts to increase engagement in prevention and care, address stigma, and build trust in HIV care among communities most disproportionately impacted by HIV and AIDS. Priority is given to proposals submitted before July 7th.

\$20 Million granted to The Miami Foundation to Strengthen Small Businesses in Miami

The Miami Foundation has launched the Miami Open for Business initiative to support small, historically disadvantaged, minority business owners to own more of their businesses' assets, such as property, equipment, and technology.
