I. <u>Call to Order/Roll Call</u>

Jasmin O'Neale, CQM Committee vice-chair, called the meeting to order at 9:33 a.m. She requested a moment of silence.

II. <u>Roll Call</u>

Members noted their presence by indicating "Here" or "Present" in the chat box.

III. <u>Review Agenda & Minutes</u>

The committee reviewed today's agenda and the meeting minutes from January 21, 2022. No changes were made, both items were approved. Next steps from the last meeting minutes were reviewed.

IV. <u>Icebreaker activity</u>

Barbara Kubilus engaged the CQM Committee members in an icebreaker activity. The members watched a video on creating a culture of continuous improvement. <u>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=kcBC3xhjyx8</u> Ms. Kubilus requested feedback on ways to improve the continuous improvement culture at their respective agencies.

V. Quality Improvement Feedback Hour Part II

Citrus Health Network (CHN)

Emma Muñoz presented Citrus Health Network's QI project planning responses (copy on file). Ms. Munoz indicated that they have identified Hispanic Male to Male Sexual Contact (MMSC) as their priority population. They currently only have one location that serves Ryan White Program clients from 8am-5pm Monday to Friday.

Ms. Muñoz and the QI team used the 5 Why's to identify the contributing factors for nonviral load suppression. They identified several root causes that include non-adherence to treatment regimen, depression, work schedule, no shows for medical appointments, and lack of understanding of medication regimen. CHN determined that the focus of their QI project will be on clients who do not follow up with PCP appointments. They will continue working with BSR CQM staff to initiate their QI project.

VI. Data Analysis Hour

Jimmy Hernandez reviewed with the CQM Committee members the data dashboard he created aimed to assist subrecipients with identifying areas for improvement. He provided a

demonstration of all the features included in the dashboard (VL status, retention in care status, distribution of clients by gender, risk factor, race/ethnicity, and age) as well as pivot tables and graphs. He explained he uses Structured Query Language (SQL) to pull the data from Provide Enterprise. Mr. Hernandez explained that he will provide the key to the indicators on the dashboard for additional clarity and offered to provide one-on-one assistance with the dashboard upon request.

VII. Voting

The CQM Committee members voted for the chair and vice-chair using the polling feature on Zoom. The new chair of the CQM committee is Rhonda Wright from Borinquen Health Care Center and the new vice-chair of the committee is Brad Mester from AIDS Healthcare Foundation.
