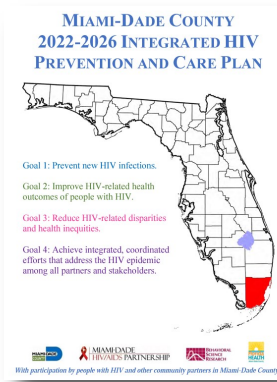

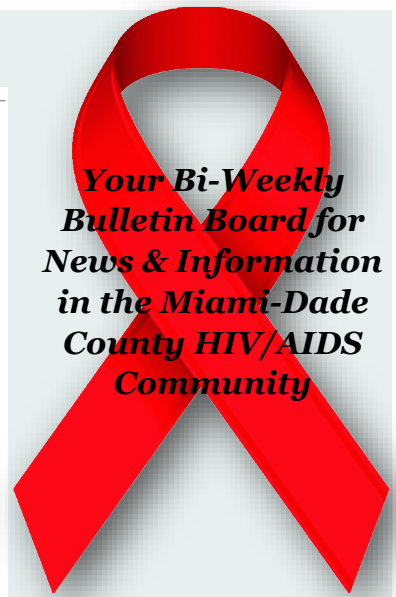

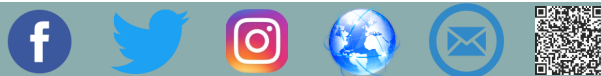

NIH/ACTG STOMP Trial of tecovirimat (TPOXX) treatment for human Monkeypox is open at University of Miami All patients with suspected/likely MPX for <14 days that have active (not crusted) skin and/or mucosal lesions are eligible. Diagnostics will be done through the study. This is an important study for establishing TPOXX efficacy. Please feel free to distribute the information widely.
