# What is Florida Black HIV/AIDS Coalition?

The **Florida Black HIV/AIDS Coalition** is a collaborative of providers serving the Black community. There are 4 chapters in the state of Florida: in Miami-Dade, Broward, Melbourne and the Big Bend area.

Purpose of the meetings are to inform, network, train, and coordinate actions to reduce new HIV infections; increase access to care, improve health outcomes; reduce HIV related disparities; and plan activities to achieve a more coordinated response to the HIV epidemic in Miami-Dade County.

## Expectations for Members:

- Attend at least 2 meeting(s) and/or event(s) including quarterly activities
- Mandatory attendance for Contracted Providers; providers would need to let us know ahead of time if unable to attend
- Guide the chapter through active participation in meetings and events
- Support the programmatic efforts of the chapter



# National Black HIV/AIDS Awareness Day (NBHAAD) event:

- Distributed 3,540 total condoms
- Total of 58 total individuals tested for HIV
- Distributed 8 in-home HIV testing
- Total of 30 PrEP referrals were provided



# SOS – SISTAS Organizing to Survive



Sistas Organizing to Survive (SOS) is the grassroots mobilization of black women in the fight against HIV/AIDS.

Launched on June 20, 2008, SOS encourages black women to get tested where they live, work, play, and worship.
