In It Together: Improving Health Literacy for Black MSM is a health literacy training initiative for health professionals serving Black/African American gay, bisexual, same gender loving and other men who have sex with men (MSM).

The **free**, **1 hour**, **in-person** In It Together Community Training is designed to help health professionals understand how limited health literacy affects the health of their clients. This training helps health professionals:

- **Recognize** signs that their clients are experiencing limited health literacy
- **Apply** health literate approaches to improve their communication with clients
- **Identify** steps their organization can take to promote health literacy and deliver health literate HIV services
