Dirty . . . Clean . . . Full-blown AIDS . . . Victim . . .

Membership

Members were given a copy of the draft Recruitment Campaign developed by members who were part of the JSI/Target HIV Retention and Recruitment training in 2020. Staff suggested a review, update, and adoption of a recruitment plan; to be further discussed at upcoming meetings.

The Partnership will have a table at the June 4 HALO Awards recognizing HIV Long Term Survivors Day. Staff will coordinate to have Partnership promotional materials available at the event.

National HIV Testing Day (NTD) Event Participation

In lieu of the June meeting, members will attend various NTD events at Walgreens and other locations. Staff will coordinate with members to make sure they have Partnership promotional materials.

AIDS Walk Miami Update

There was no update since the April meeting: Staff is monitoring the AIDS Walk Miami website for updates on the 2022 event; no details have been posted. Historically, the Partnership has hosted a table at AIDS Walk Miami.

IX. New Business

Health Care Disparities Highlighted by the COVID-19 Pandemic

Allison Ruby

Allison Ruby, Merck community liaison, presented *Health Care Disparities Highlighted by the COVID-19 Pandemic*. The presentation noted the how both minority populations and people experiencing poverty were disproportionately negatively impacted by COVID-19. Particularly in the pre-vaccine days, the number of hospitalizations and deaths among African-Americans was disproportionately high compared to the population numbers. The presentation noted specific challenges for people with HIV in both preventing and treating COVID-19. The presentation also described efforts to bring COVID-19 awareness and access to treatment to as many people as possible, noting that if you don't know about available services, those services are not really available to you. Also highlighted was the overwhelming volume of information and misinformation and the difficulties of navigating an "info-demic." Members thanked Ms. Ruby for her presentation.

Target HIV Transgender Training Program

Lamar McMullen

Mr. McMullen announced that he has been a collaborator in developing an upcoming TargetHIV training focusing on cultural sensitivity and inclusion of transgender people in community planning. Mr. McMullen will also be a featured presenter on the final training. The date of the training is pending.

Language Matter Update to Housekeeping PowerPoint

Based on language provided by Positive People Network, staff was instructed to include a slide addressing People First Language and do's and don't's in the regular meeting Housekeeping presentation.

It was noted that medical case managers (MCM) are among those who need to be reminded of People First Language. It was noted that MCM no longer empower people with HIV or act as mentors.

Motion to adapt language matters language for a new slide in the meeting Housekeeping presentation.

Partnership Report to Committees and Subcommittee July 18, 2022 Meeting

The Partnership heard reports and approved the following motions:

- 1. Motion to adopt the updated Code of Conduct.
- 2. Motion to accept the "Dear Colleague" letter regarding gender-affirming care, with changes.
- 3. Motion to add codes to the Ryan White Oral Health Care Formulary: D6010 (Surgical placement of implant body, second-stage surgery, placement of healing cap); D6191 (Semi-precision abutment-placement); D6192 (Semi-precision attachment-placement); D6110 (Implant/abutment supported removal denture for edentulous arch-maxillary); and D6111 (Implant/abutment supported removal denture for edentulous arch-mandibular). As detailed in the Letter of Medical Necessity for Dental Implants, the implants are not cosmetic. They are for edentulous patients [patients lacking teeth] with insufficient bone support for conventional complete dentures and/or advanced resorption of the bone that supports dentures so they have difficulty keeping them in place. Limit is 8 units.
- 4. Motion to accept the Letter of Medical Necessity for Dental Implants with changes.
- 5. Motion to have an effective start date of August 1, 2022 [for the above referenced changes], pending approval by the Partnership of the Letter of Medical Necessity for Dental Implants.
- 6. Motion to accept the Other Professional Services: Legal Services and Permanency Planning services description with gender-affirming language as presented.
- 7. Motion to allocate \$766,083 of Part A Sweeps 2 funds to the Food Bank service category.
- 8. Motion to allocate Part A Sweeps 2 funds:\$5,815,461 to Medical Case Management; \$8,577,172 to Outpatient/Ambulatory Health Services; \$132,385 to Mental Health Services; \$84,492 to AIDS Pharmaceutical Assistance; \$3,088,975 to Oral Health Care; \$335,776 to Health Insurance Services; \$1,969,744 to Substance Abuse Residential; \$44,128 Substance Abuse Outpatient Care; \$194,149 to Medical Transportation; \$9,853 to Emergency Financial Assistance; \$264,696 to Outreach Services; and \$154,449 to Other Professional Services (Legal).
- 9. Motion to allocate MAI Sweeps 2 funds of \$6,883 to Clinical Quality Management.

10. Motion to appoint Alecia Tramel as designated Miami-Dade HIV/AIDS Partnership member liaison to the I am a Work of ART Campaign.



Overview

The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS), developed the "I am a Work of ART" national viral suppression campaign as part of the *Ending the HIV Epidemic in the U.S.* (EHE) Initiative. This campaign supports the EHE key pillar: "Treat people with HIV rapidly and effectively to reach sustained viral suppression."

Campaign Development

Eligibility

Who can submit an Expense Report?

- Persons with HIV who are members of the Partnership, its committees, subcommittees, and workgroups.
- Partnership members designated to act on behalf of the Partnership at approved events.









Allowable Expenses

Mileage

Allowable Expenses

- Driving your automobile to and/or from a Partnership, committee, subcommittee, or workgroup meeting; or
- Driving your automobile to and/or from approved events at which you are acting as a designated Partnership representative.

Calculating Mileage

- Mileage rate is based on the IRS rate for use of privately owned vehicles.
- Mileage is calculated by Staff as the shortest door-to-door distance using Google Maps.









Allowable Expenses

Rideshares & Public Transportation

Calculating Rideshare Reimbursement

Rideshares are services such as Uber, Lyft, or taxis.



- Rideshare reimbursement is calculated by Staff as the shortest door-to-door distance IN MILES using Google Maps.
- Mileage rate is based on the IRS rate for use of privately owned vehicles.
- Rideshare expenses must be documented by receipt.

Bus, Rail, or Shuttle

Expenses are reimbursable as documented by receipt.







Allowable Expenses

Parking & Tolls



Miami-Dade County Main Library - Cultural Center Garage

- Staff will provide a parking voucher after each meeting, for eligible members.
- Street or other garage parking will not be reimbursed unless the Cultural Center Garage is full.
- It is not necessary to file for reimbursement for parking at the Cultural Center Garage for meetings at the MDC Main Library.

Behavioral Science Research (BSR) Garage at 2121 Ponce de Leon Boulevard

- Staff will validate parking for all meeting attendees.
- It is not necessary to file for reimbursement for parking at BSR.

Other

- Parking will be reimbursed at approved events at which the member is acting as a designated Partnership representative.
- Toll charges will be reimbursed as documented by SunPass or other toll road receipt.






Completing the Expense Report Form

- Complete the highlighted fields as noted
- Forms must be submitted no more than four (4) months after the expense was incurred.
- Allow fifteen (15) business days for processing.
- Checks will be mailed to the address listed on the Expense Report Form.

Checks that have not been cashed within six (6) months of being issued will be voided. After 6 months, Staff is not required to replace uncashed, misplaced, or lost checks.


