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Edentulous patients with insufficient bone support for conventional Complete Dentures:

These are the patients that have no remaining teeth and advanced resorption of the bone that supports the dentures, so they have difficulty keeping them in place. Four implants per arch could be placed for the dentures to clip on.

^{*} This is a general code used for the placement of any kind of implant. It would be necessary to specify coverage limited to edentulous patients up to 8 units (4 implants are necessary per arch), most patients need only one arch though.

Codes are restricted up to 8 units.
