I. <u>Call to Order/Roll Call</u>

Rhonda Wright, CQM Committee chair, called the meeting to order at 9:32 a.m.

II. <u>Roll Call (Zoom Attendees)</u>

III. <u>Review Agenda & Minutes</u>

The committee reviewed today's agenda and the meeting minutes from January 20, 2023. No changes were made.

IV. <u>Presentation on the Status Neutral Approach</u>

Bolivar Nieto from Gilead Science presented the Status Neutral Approach. The Status Neutral Approach to HIV care emphasizes a holistic or whole person approach to the way services are provided to clients with HIV regardless if the services provided are for HIV treatment. This framework's goal is to reduce HIV related stigma by addressing the needs of clients ahead of their HIV status.

Mr. Nieto discussed ways subrecipients can implement the status neutral approach to improve the client experience and increase retention in care. The goal is for subrecipients to potentially implement the status neutral approach across Ryan White Program sites.

V. <u>Care Resource's Minority AIDS Initiative Best</u> <u>Practice Showcase</u>

Edgar Mojica presented Care Resource's i- ENGAGE and Protocol for Responding to and Assessing Patients' Assets, Risks, and Experiences (PRAPARE) MAI innovation (copy on file). Their innovation targets Black and Hispanic females and Hispanic MSMs with hypertension and/or diabetes while addressing each MAI client's social determinant of care and viral suppression.

Care Resource's MAI clients receive ongoing i-ENGAGE, a behavioral intervention during their MCM and peer encounters at all CRCHC sites to address the client-specific social determinants of health. Mr. Mojica reported that the MAI innovation has had significant success. He confirmed that pre-MAI innovation, the viral suppression rate was 78% and post-MAI innovation, the viral suppression rate is above the program average of 87%.
