### □ Partnership Second Term Application

## Recruitment Roundtable: New Application Process

Staff advised on a new Partnership application process to eliminate the 7 page membership application. The new process would be five (5) steps:

- 2. Staff and/or a Coalition member will conduct an initial interview and collect demographic data for the application.
- 3. Applicant will be interviewed by members.

- 5. Recommendations will be forwarded to the Partnership and additional steps will take place in the usual manner.
