## Mpox and HIV

Dr. Alvaro Mejia-Echeverry, Florida Department of Health (FDOH), presented Mpox and HIV via Zoom. The presentation was a broad overview of Mpox, including the virus definition and history; transmission vectors; explanation of the name change from monkeypox to Mpox; rash identification; incubation period; the global and local impacts and demographics; TPOXX treatment and dispensing data; vaccination data; and other factors to be aware of during an outbreak. Members thanked Dr. Mejia-Echeverry for the comprehensive information.

## □ Florida Black HIV/AIDS Coalition – Miami Chapter

## ☐ Hispanic Initiative (Iniciativa Hispana)

Juliana Shapiro reported on recent presentations and member activities and asked Prevention Committee members how Hispanic Initiative could help support their work. She suggested collaborations around National Faith HIV and AIDS Awareness Day, National Latinx AIDS Awareness Day, and WAD; and highlighted member agencies in the workgroup. Mr. Ferrer advised on discussions around recent LGBTQ+ legislation; highlighted upcoming activities; and announced Alex Moro and Anthony Monsalve as the WG's new Community Co-chairs.
