Sexually transmitted infections (STIs) in the US are steadily on the rise. According to CDC surveillance, 2.4 million cases of chlamydia, gonorrhea, and syphilis were reported in 2020. STIs can spread among people who are asymptomatic, cause serious, long-term health problems if left untreated, and increase the likelihood of HIV acquisition and transmission . . .


