FDOH Family Planning Services

- Prevention of unintended pregnancies and elective abortions are priorities of Public health.
- Our goal is to improve women's health before, during and beyond pregnancy.
- Our program provides information on baby spacing, abstinence, avoiding sexually transmitted diseases or infections (STIs) and contraceptive methods.

FDOH Family Planning Services

- Yearly Exams for Women & Men
 - Prescription/referrals for diagnostic testing
- All contraceptive choices
 - The pill
 - The shot
 - The vaginal ring
 - IUD's
 - Hormonal Implants
 - Including male sterilizations
- Emergency Contraception Pill
- Free Condoms



FDOH Prenatal Care Clinic

- Prenatal care counseling and education
- Education on breastfeeding and safe sleep practices
- Application for PEPW Emergency Medicaid for Pregnant Women
- WIC eligibility / referrals
- Healthy Start screenings
- Post partum care
- HIV testing
- STDs testing and treatment
- Referrals as needed

PEPW Emergency Medicaid for Pregnant Women

- PEPW- Presumptive Eligibility for Pregnant Women
- Coverage withing 24 to 48 hours through partnership with DCF
- Prenatal care office visits and ultrasounds
- Transportation
- Provide informational sheet with Pin number, Case number and DCF website and contact number



Cost of Services for Family Planning & Prenatal Care

- Sliding fee scale based on income Federal poverty levels
- No minimum payment required for services
- Medicaid/HMO's
- Some commercial insurance
- Picture ID required
- e.g. Foreign country passport





- Teams of walkers (minimum 5 per team) from organizations; schools, citizen groups; government and elected official's offices; family, friends, and neighbors
- Teams are encouraged to create a team tshirt with a HIV prevention message
- Displays around the track telling the stories of those living with HIV/AIDS and those lost to AIDS related infections
- Speakers, testimonials, entertainers sharing the message that HIV is preventable and treatable



Purpose of the Walk

- Bring attention to Miami Dade County's incidence of HIV transmission
- Walkers & community learn their HIV/AIDS status through onsite testing
- Educate community about testing and treatment for successful outcomes
- Honor those living with AIDS and remember those lost to AIDS related opportunistic infections
- Reduce the stigma of HIV




