Are you **homeless** or unstably housed?







The Health Council of South Florida (HCSF) Rapid Re-housing Program, funded by Miami-Dade County, provides assistance to individuals living with HIV/AIDS who are homeless or are experiencing housing instability. Limited funding is available and assistance will be provided to eligible persons on first-come, first-serve basis until funds are exhausted.

- Applicant must be HIV+
- Currently homeless or unstably housed
- Applicant is not receiving housing assistance from another program
