The City of Miami's Department of Housing & Community Development invites non-profit public service agencies and HIV/AIDS service providers to attend the Proposal Workshops to be held this February, for assistance with submitting a Request for Proposal (RFP) via ZoomGrants™ for those applicants seeking Community Development Block Grants (CDBG), Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG), and/or Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA) funds for Fiscal Year 2025-2026 (51st Year) and Fiscal Year 2026-2027 (52nd Year).

Two (2) different RFPs were issued on **Monday, February 3, 2025, and their submission deadline has been extended until Monday, March 24, 2025, midnight.** Two additional workshops will be held in March to address the CDBG/ESG RFP as listed in the schedule below.
