- Using the table above as a guide for families/households with more than eight (8) members, add \$5,500 for EACH additional family/household member.
- The Miami-Dade County Ryan White Program Provide® Enterprise Miami data management system will be programmed according to these guidelines, effective March 1, 2025 through February 28, 2026.
- Income eligibility for the following Ryan White Part A and Minority AIDS Initiative (MAI) Program-funded services in Miami-Dade County is limited to program-eligible clients who have a gross household income at or below 400% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL). The 400% FPL income limit applies to all locally-funded Ryan White Part A and MAI Program service categories, except Food Bank services whose limit is 250% of the FPL.
- Please be advised that this document is simply an internal reference tool and the rounding calculations may be slightly off.** Percentage calculations in the table above are rounded to avoid gaps between whole number dollar amounts. The first number for each household size in column A is exact per the HHS Poverty Guidelines for 2025, as are the calculations in the Provide® Enterprise Miami data management system.
